WHS MARCHING BAND CAMP INFORMATION

(Marching Band members: bring this information to camp with you)

Updated 5.29.15

Prior to the start of the academic year, the Williamston High School Hornet Marching Band will be traveling to Kimball YMCA Center located in Reading, Michigan for one week of band camp in preparation for the upcoming marching band season. Upon arrival to the high school on Monday, August 3, all members should first CHECK IN at the registration tables set up in the band room. After finishing registration, report to the parking area to load all marching band equipment and personal belongings onto the buses and equipment truck. The buses will transport the marching band to Kimball YMCA Center, leaving at 9:00 a.m.

A typical day of the preseason camp includes the rehearsal of marching music repertoire as well as marching fundamental drills. The outdoor drills have the function of developing marching fundamentals and preparing for the initial appearance of the band at Friday night Williamston football games.

- Depart: Monday, August 3rd, 9:00 am., Williamston High School
Return: Saturday, August 8th – Students will be dismissed after our “informance”
Students must arrange for their own transportation home
- Address: Kimball YMCA Camp, 4444 Long Lake Road, Reading, MI 49274
- In case of emergencies where your parents need to reach you, the camp telephone number is **1-517-283-2168. This is for an emergency only.**
- The following rules will be strictly enforced: NO DRUGS! NO ALCOHOL! NO SMOKING! Any infraction of these rules will result in the parent/guardian being notified immediately and asked to take the student home – regardless of the time of day or night. All student camp fees will be forfeited. Further disciplinary action as per the WHS school policies will be determined by Ms. Kelsey and Dr. Thoenes when we return from camp.
- Destruction of property or stealing will not be tolerated.
- Boys and girls will not be allowed in each others cabins at any time.
- Special medication and pills are to be turned over to the camp nurse for dispensing. Medication may not be kept in cabins.
- All students will be responsible for the clean-up of their cabins. Students will take turns with the set-up and clean-up of the dining area.
- Swimming is allowed only when the life guard is on duty.

- Athletic or comfortable work out shoes and socks (NO SANDALS or BARE FEET) must be worn at every rehearsal.

- Things that you need to bring to camp include:

Marching instrument, reeds, tuba bits, etc., WHS summer marching uniform (official green band performance tee, official black band shorts, black socks, official black marching shoes), pencils - bring to every rehearsal (hook it to your instrument), water bottles, music lyres and flip folders (if you don't have one you can pick one up at any music store), insect repellent (a must for evening rehearsals), comfortable workout type shoes and socks (no sandals for rehearsals), suntan lotion, sleeping bag/pillow or sheets and blankets, pajamas, sweatshirt/jacket, long pants/jeans/shorts, bathrobe, recreation equipment, soap/comb/brush, other personal grooming items, sun glasses/hat, underwear/socks, laundry bag, swimsuit, towels/washcloths, Kleenex

- Have your personal belongings marked with your name.
- Do not bring large trunks (larger than what would qualify for the airlines – garbage bags will be provided and you will be asked to “repack”). Stereo/gaming systems, refrigerators, grills, etc. will not be allowed to be loaded on the bus or trailer. Do not bring them.
- Your parents and friends are encouraged to visit the camp and observe our final drill on Saturday, August 8th at 9:00 AM. We look forward to seeing many parents and alumni at this “informance”. We will be wearing our summer band uniform (green band performance tee, black band shorts, black socks, and black marching shoes) for that performance so make sure you pack accordingly for the last day of camp! New members will be issued their green band performance tee, black band shorts, and marching shoes at camp. We always try to look sharp for this last camp rehearsal / first real performance.
- Forms, fees, student camp housing: Fill out the enclosed camp fee worksheet, student/parent contract agreement, band camp health form, participation/travel permission form and return them with your band camp payment in the enclosed envelope. All forms are due June 10th and all fee balances are due July 27, 2015 unless prior arrangements have been made. Your parents must sign these forms. You are not required to visit your physician, but the health form must be filled out as completely as possible. Send all forms and fees to: WHS Band Camp Forms and Fees Coordinator, P.O. Box 85, Williamston, MI 48895. **Once you have sent in the forms and fees, you can then call to sign up for cabin housing. You may call the Band Camp Student Housing Coordinator, Mrs. Carolyn McLaughlin, 517-290-4977 only after sending in your payment and forms. When calling Mrs. McLaughlin to sign up for a cabin please leave a message for her if she does not answer.**

- Pre camp sectionals: Sectionals may be initiated by the section leader and held before camp for each section of the marching band. Specific information will come to you from the section leaders.
- The WHS Marching Band uniform will be supplied to all wind and percussion instrument players. Uniforms for wind and percussion instrument players will be newly issued during our pre-camp rehearsals in the HS band room.
- The summer uniform green band performance tee and black band shorts should be purchased by all band members. This uniform will be worn as an alternative to the full marching uniform when the weather is extremely warm.
- All new band members, including color guard, should plan to purchase a pair of black marching shoes (\$35). Properly cared for, this shoe will last all four years and be very comfortable for marching. Students will be fit for shoes on August 3rd during registration. Please make sure to wear socks for this fitting process.
- All new band members should plan to purchase a concert uniform shirt. The price for the female shirt is \$40. The price for the male shirt is \$25.00. Students will be fit for concert uniform shirts on August 3rd during registration.
